AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 13250 TO CHAPTER  
3, TITLE XIV, GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM,  
WITH REFERENCE TO THE AUTHORIZATION OF  
THE TERRITORIAL PLANNING COMMISSION TO  
UNDERTAKE URBAN PLANNING AND TO ACCEPT  
GRANTS FROM THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT .

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 13250 is hereby added to Chapter 3, Title XIV,  
Government Code of Guam, to read as follows:

"Section 13250. Urban Planning. The Commission is  
authorized to undertake urban planning, including without  
limitation, the making of planning surveys, land use studies,  
urban renewal plans, technical services, and other planning  
work, for Guam as a whole, for portions of Guam as regional  
or metropolitan areas, and for urban communities in Guam.  
The Commission is authorized to accept grants from the Federal  
Government and other public or private sources and to contract  
with reference thereto, to authorize the expenditure of such  
grants for the purposes set forth in this section by the Depart-  
ment of Land Management for personnel and facilities provided  
by the Department pursuant to Section 13203 of this Chapter, and  
to exercise all other powers necessary to carry out the purposes  
of this section."

Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
