## CHAMORRO LAND TRUST COMMISSION RESOLUTION NO. 2009-03

At the meeting of the Chamorro Land Trust Commission Board on June 18, 2009 a Resolution was proposed and approved.

## **RESOLVED:**

WHEREAS, the Chamorro Land Trust Commission is responsible for the disposition of Chamorro Land Trust properties. Pursuant to mandates to advance the social, cultural and economic development and well-being of the Chamorro people by way of Residential, Agricultural, Commercial land distribution and economic assistance programs; and

WHEREAS, Government of Guam Association of Retired Persons, Inc. (GGARP) is a non-profit organization that was founded to improve the moral, social, mental and general welfare of retirees of the Government of Guam and functions lawfully as any other non-profit organization may; and

WHEREAS, GGARP is in need of providing more space for facilities that may accommodate educational, physical and social interaction and has plans to request for federal and local grants to construct a multi-generational building adjacent to its present location in Hagatna and to be used by all retirees, senior citizens and youths of Guam.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Chamorro Land Trust Commission endorses the plans of GGARP to request the Guam Legislature to transfer to its organization a portion of Lot 86-R2 of an area of 1.5 acres, Municipality of Agana and to be consolidated with Lot 86-2, Municipality of Agana, subject to survey for said purposed multi-generational facility. All rights and title to such property shall revert back to the Chamorro Land Trust Commission at any time the property is no longer being used as a facility for GGARP.

This Resolution was enacted by the Chamorro Land Trust Commission at its official meeting on June 18, 2009.
