The Vision of the Chamorro Land Trust Commission

The homelands of the Chamorro people, first taken by others over 150 years prior, have been returned to the Chamorro people as a place to live, sustain themselves and build productive lives.

Chamorro Land Trust properties are comprised of:

- Clean, safe and thriving neighborhoods, where neighbors practice inafa'maolek and all live with dignity; and
- Productive agricultural tracts of land that are nurtured with best management practices and lead the island's agriculture market; and
- Sensitive ecological and culturally significant lands that are protected and preserved for future generations; and
- Sound commercial enterprise that enhance the livelihood and well-being of the Chamorro people.

The Chamorro Land Trust Commission, through comprehensive land use planning, robust financial management, and strong partnerships to enhance the abilities of the Chamorro people, has benefitted not just the Chamorro people and the island's environment, but all who love and call Guam home.
